

"Memorial Tribute to Professor Lucie Cheng to be held at UCLA on Tuesday, April 20, 2010 from 4-6 p.m. at the UCLA Faculty Center"

The UCLA Asian American Studies Center and Department of Sociology will host a memorial tribute for the late Professor Lucie Cheng on Tuesday, April 20, 2010 from 4-6 pm at the UCLA Faculty Center.

Professor Cheng passed away on 27 January 2010 in Taipei, Taiwan after courageously battling cancer for several years. The pioneering scholar will be remembered for placing Asian Americans at the forefront of class, gender and labor, breaking away from stereotypes that saw them as either the victims of their circumstances or the pawns of history as well as for her many contributions at the university.
